How to apply for funding from the Rotary Club of Allen if you are a non-profit agency, community or education organization

All requests must be submitted in writing and must include:

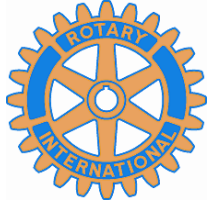
- A complete INFORMATION / CONTACT SHEET (page 1)
 - The dollar amount requested and a detailed budget for the project (page 2)
 - A summary of the proposed program or project, including specific goals and objectives (no more than 2 pages)
 - Audit or financial statements for the most recently completed fiscal year
 - Proof of tax-exempt status
 - List of staff and board of directors
 - Other sources of support for the project or program
 - Contact name, address and phone number

 - The dollar amount requested and a detailed budget for the project (page 2)
 - A summary of the need or project (no more than 1 page please)

Frequently asked questions

Q

How often does the Allen Noon Rotary Club meet to consider requests?

A: The Rotary Club invites requests for donations each year; the deadline for applications for Rotary year 2010-2011 is February 26, 2011.

A: Grant amounts vary widely, but typically are \$3,000 or less.

Will we need to make a presentation to the Rotary board?

A: This depends upon the request; is not normally required.

Q

What type of reporting is required of organizations receiving funds from Rotary?

A: The Rotary Club requires a summary report at the end of the organization's fiscal year or at the end of the project for which funds were requested; this report should include how funds were used and the impact on our community.

Our application for tax exempt status is pending. Will you consider our proposal?
